A statement from Sir Geoffrey Clifton-Brown, Chair of the Committee of Public Accounts:

"NHS dentistry is in a state of crisis. People across the country are struggling to access NHS dentists, particularly in rural areas.

The roll out of dental vans and 'golden hello' bonuses to under-served communities has been slow and the Dental Recovery Plan is now unlikely to deliver its ambitions for 1.5 million extra treatments.

The Department of Health and Social Care and NHS England must take stock of what works if they are to address the serious challenges facing NHS Dentistry."
